Angus Buchan was a white Zambian farmer of Scottish origin who moved to South Africa to escape political unrest and worrying land reforms. With nothing more than a



trailer, the Buchan family struggled to settle in their new homeland and Angus began to spiral downward because of the challenges he faced trying to establish a farm.

He attended a local church and decided to rededicate his life to the Lord after hearing the testimonies of other farmers. His outlook completely turned around and supernatural occurrences begin to happen when Angus prayed in faith.

He began giving his testimony in different towns, and eventually gathered thousands of people in a soccer stadium for a time of prayer for the nation and for the land.

Traditionally a corn and cattle farmer, Angus decided to plant potatoes even though there was a drought. Despite the risk due to lack of irrigation, Angus made the decision to plant potatoes in the dry dirt and was rewarded with a crop of giant potatoes at harvest time.
