SATAN'S CONDITION

- He has been defeated. Isaiah 14:15-20
- □ His body was destroyed. Ezekiel 28:18
- He is no longer the ruler of this earth. **Colossians 2:8-15**

SATAN'S WEAPONS

Deception and lies were used against Eve: Genesis 3:1-6

ACTIVITIES BEFORE THE CROSS

- □ Satan tried to destroy Job with unjust charges, Job was unable to take any defensive action! Job 1:6-21, 2:1-10
- □ King Saul fought an evil spirit with music of praise. I Samuel 16:14-23
- Daniel used prayer and fasting to get something done. Daniel 10:1-14

WHAT JESUS DID

- □ Jesus fought the Devil with the Word of God. Luke 4:1-13
- Jesus had total control over evil spirits. Luke 4:31-41
- □ Jesus took dominion. Mark 9:14-19
- Jesus projected his power. Luke 8:22-39, 11:14-26
- □ Unbelief hindered Jesus from working in his hometown. Matthew 13: 53-58
- □ Jesus did not violate man's free will. Matthew 19:16-24
- □ Jesus ripped off the chains of the crippled woman. Luke 13:10-17

WHAT JESUS TAUGHT

- □ The strong man must be bound before any action can be taken. Luke 11:17-23
- □ The binding of the strong man was transferred to the disciples. Matthew 16:13-19

JESUS TRANSFERRED HIS AUTHORITY TO THE BELIEVERS

- Luke 9:1-5, 10:1-21
- □ Matthew 28:18-20

JESUS IS THE SUPREME RULER

Revelation 1:7-18
