PART 2: FACING THE IMPOSSIBLE

There are physical and spiritual laws. Both sets of law are real and will determine the outcome of any project a person embarks upon. They cannot be negated and were set in stone by God before He began the creation of the universe. **Isaiah 46:9-10; Psalm 119:89**

THE LAW OF FAITH

The Law of Faith is the cornerstone in God's creation of man. This is such a law that when broken will bring the wrath of God. **Hebrews 3:7-19**

Abraham believed God and it was counted as righteousness. **Romans 4:1-3**

God doesn't move without faith. **James 1:1-7**

When a Christian doubts God, he is in reality insulting God because he doesn't believe God is capable of responding with a solution. **Hebrews 11:6**

Rejecting God's commandments and doubting His ability to carry a project out makes God angry. **Exodus 4:1-17**

True faith is an absolute belief that God is supreme, His word is forever, and that whatever He has said in the Bible is truth and will be trusted to the end of the world. **Hebrews 11:1-3**

FACING THE IMPOSSIBLE

After Moses had seen the judgment on the Egyptians with the ten plagues, any doubt had been turned into faith in God. Faith never grows without a challenge. God didn't need Moses to help in parting the Red Sea; rather, Moses needed God to part the Red Sea. God created a situation that no man could solve:

1. God hardened the heart of Pharaoh. **Exodus 14:1-9**
2. The children of Israel had no faith in God. **verses 11-12**
3. Moses told the people to have faith in God. **verses 13-14**
4. God told Moses to stop crying out to Him and instead move the people forward. **verses 15-20**
5. God wants His people to participate in His supernatural miracles. God didn't need Moses to hold out his rod; rather, Moses needed to hold up his rod, so he in faith would know that he had a part in the parting of the Red Sea. **verses 21-28**



SUMMARY

God wanted Moses and the two widows to be part of the miracles. By taking part, each one had to show their faith in God. When Jesus healed people, He always talked to them first and asked them what they wanted. Jesus performed the miracle once they responded in faith. **Matthew 9:1-8**

Jesus expects us to participate when we ask Him for a miracle and believe that He is going to meet our needs. **Mark 11:22-24**

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
