RISE OF THE CLONES

Jesus replies: "You are a lazy servant who did not take the time to read the Bible. You are without an excuse. I sentence you to be taken by the tormenting angels to a prison of correction where you will be tormented until you have paid your debts." **verses 34-35**

"When it comes to your rewards and position in eternity," Jesus continues, "These things will be calculated by the angels once you emerge from prison. Angels, take him away!"

As millions of believers stand outside the court and watch the proceedings on giant television screens, a hush falls over the crowd as each man and woman begins to recount what took place during their time on earth.
